Description: This shrub has bright green leaves, which are small, linear and grow in large tufts on the light coloured woody branches.

It is thought that this shrub may flower in winter, following rainfall. In July it had old flower heads on, as well as the buds of new flowers not yet opened. It appeared that the shrub had flowered a second time, following rain in June.

Habitat: This shrub grows at the top of the Losberg mountain, where the temperature and moisture are quite different to the rest of the reserve. At this altitude of around 1900m, it is quite common, growing amongst large granite rocks.
