

Jamesbrittenia hereroensis

Family: Scrophulariaceae (snapdragon family)



Collection Number: 38

Description: A small annual herb, only a few centimetres in height. It has a single tap root and a single stem or the stem branches into two. The leaves are small and simple. The flower is pink / lilac and has 5 petals. The plant was flowering in July, following excellent summer rainfall.

Habitat: Amongst rocks, stony areas with gravel. It is a common annual on Namibia, but grows in areas of partial shade such as amongst granite boulders on Gorrasis and around Bushman koppies.
