Description: a prostrate herb with simple, egg-shaped leaves. The purple flowers are small and inconspicuous, and produced in auxillary clusters. Flowering is in summer. The fruit is a round pod.

Habitat: This small shrub grows in deep sand, and is found in the dunes of the Namib and the Kalahari.
